INTERNSHIP DESCRIPTION:

***This internship is not paid.**

Assist foster youth, ages 14-21, to successfully transition out of the state foster care system

Conduct Life Skills Assessments and develop and update written Transition Plan for each client

Deliver services according to the Transition Plan for each client

Provide outreach to foster youth, group homes, foster parents and social workers to encourage youth involvement in ILP activities

Work to maximize program access for youth through home visits and arranging transportation to and from activities and classes

Maintain case files for assigned participants

Assist in organizing activities

Act as a liaison with other community service agencies to provide support for participants.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: ***Strong interest in working with at-risk teenagers.*** Ability to maintain a professional work ethic, establish and maintain boundaries while working with a diverse population, and reporting content of individual meetings. ***This internship is not paid.** You will receive valuable experience in the social service field, great networking opportunities, and access to state-wide trainings. Upon completion of a successful internship you will have developed valuable job references. Preference is given to those with social service and/or education backgrounds or coursework. **Applicant must pass a background check that includes fingerprinting.**
