Native Supports address the needs of Native Americans in the Columbia Gorge. Connecting with culturally specific resources and knowledge to support Native communities.

Programs:

Natives Along the Big River (NABR) or Neighbor: Native American Leadership coalition that advocates for equitable services for all Native Americans in the Gorge

Native American Youth Outreach Worker:

Native American student support service that provides emotional and academic support, resource connection, and referrals.

- Housing, food, physical and mental health
- Support for students struggling with attendance, poor academic performance, family conflict, and personal crises

Native American HealthConnect Pathways:

Helps access services in Klickitat and Skamania Counties like Medical, Dental or Mental Health Care, Utility & Finance Assistance, Housing Support, Transportation, and food.

Aging and People with Disabilities Tribal Navigator:

Is able to assist in explaining what the process of applying for services will be like, coordinate services with the tribe, Oregon Department of Human Services staff and more!
